





HOW TO PREPARE FOR A BED BUG CHEMICAL TREATMENT

PRIOR TO TREATMENT

- Reduce clutter in the entire residence, especially in bedrooms and living room.
- Vacuum the whole house or suite, and throw out the vacuum bag or clean the vacuum immediately.
- Move everything at least 2 feet away from the walls. Heavy items and electronic equipment may be left in place. Stand mattress and box spring upright against the walls.
- Children's toys should be covered and placed in a safe place.
- PLEASE DO NOT place items on tops of beds, chairs, sofas and couches. The heat or laundry items should be bagged and can be placed in the living room, or on the counters and tables.
- If heavily infested, heat all laundry especially bedding in the dryer for 20 minutes on high to kill bed bugs and eggs inside. Dry clean as needed. Eg: clothes, bedding, curtains, couch cushions covers.

ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- Please vacuum daily for the first week after treatment and vacuum regularly. That will reduce the bed bugs.
- Remove all the dead bugs (vacuuming can be done).
- Do laundry regularly, especially bedding and sofa blankets.
- If heavily infested, we will remove the plastic or non-bedbug proof mattress covers. Also, dust cover backing on the underside of box springs and sofas. If baseboards are infested, technician will recommend to loosen them from the walls.

SAFETY INFORMATION

All people and pets must vacate premises for a minimum of THREE (3) to FOUR (4) HOURS

People with allergies, respiratory issues, pregnant or illnesses must vacate premises for longer than FOUR (4) HOURS

Aquariums must be covered and filters should be turned off

Please avoid touching the treated areas
