





# HOW TO PREPARE FOR A COCKROACH CHEMICAL TREATMENT

#### **PRIOR TO TREATMENT**

- All the items must be removed from kitchen cupboards as well as washrooms, especially under the sinks.
- The kitchen dinning room and washroom floor must be cleared. Also, move everything 2 feet away from kitchen, dinning room and washroom walls.
- The top of refrigerators and stoves must be cleared.
- These items can be placed on the living room floor and do not require to be covered
- Please pull out the fridge and stove so that the technician can have access behind the fridge and stove.
- If heavily infested, please clear the areas around the baseboards as much as possible, in order to give access to the baseboards for treatment.

### ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATION

- Throw out garbage daily and ensure dirty dishes are not left out overnight. Fix the dripping taps or leaking pipes. Replace old or ripped shelf paper.
- After the treatment is completed all items can be put back in place.
- Remove all the dead cockroaches (vacuum can be done).
- Clean! All kitchen and bathroom surfaces must be clean and grease free, especially those areas around the fridge, stove, microwave and toaster. Also, under the sinks as well.
- Reduce clutter! Roaches feed on a huge variety of items and hide in cluttered areas, especially those near sources of heat and moisture.
- PLEASE DO NOT use insecticide sprays or harsh cleaners, as these will render our treatment ineffective.

# **SAFETY INFORMATION**

All people and pets must vacate premises for a minimum of THREE (3) to FOUR (4) HOURS

People with allergies, respiratory issues, pregnant or illnesses must vacate premises longer than FOUR (4) HOURS

Aquariums must be covered and filters should be turned off

Please avoid touching the treated areas
